

# Poppy Pattern#1

I used DK wool black, red & green (green can be used to make a leaf if you would like to add it to your poppy, see the pattern for the 2 petal Poppy where the leaf pattern is included). Use a 3.00mm or 3.25mm crochet hook.

Make a magic ring leaving sufficient black wool to use for sewing onto the display at the beginning.

1. Work 6 dc into the magic ring with black wool, pull circle tight and join with 1 chain.
2. Starting in the first chain of the ring work 2dc into each stitch creating 12sts and cast-off black wool.

## First Petal

3. Join red wool – make 2 chains. Into the first 3 stitches of the black circle, work 2 trebles into each stitch creating (6sts). 2 chain and turn work.
4. Work 2 trebles into each of the 6 stitches creating 12sts, 1 chain and turn work.
5. Now work 1 slip stitch into each of the 12 stitches. Work 4 slip stitches down the side of the petal, this will allow you to be back to the beginning of the petal, to join with a slip stitch. I found the slip stitch worked well if it was joined into edge of the black centre.

Repeat the 1st petal pattern work into 3 chains creating each petal, 4 petals in total, cast-off at the end of the 4<sup>th</sup> petal

Position petal 1 & 3 in front of petal 2 & 4 to create the poppy.
