

## Poppy Pattern#2

I used DK yarn and a 3mm hook. I have written row three as a list, stitch by stitch, hopefully to make it clearer. This is using English abbreviations.

tr = wool over yarn once

dtr = wool over twice

ddtr = wool over three times

Starting with black:

1. 6 dc into a magic ring join with slip stitch
2. 2 dc into each stitch (12 stitches) join with ss
3. Change to red yarn and work in the back of each stitch throughout
  - 2ch and 2tr into same stitch
  - 3dtr into next stitch
  - 3ddtr into next stitch \*
  - 3dtr into next stitch
  - 2tr into next stitch, 2 ch and ss into same stitch (1<sup>st</sup> petal)
  - Ss into next stitch, 2ch and 2tr into same stitch
  - 3dtr into next stitch
  - 3dtr into next stitch
  - 2ddtr into next stitch \*\*
  - 3dtr into next stitch
  - 3dtr into next stitch
  - 2tr, 2 ch and ss into same stitch (2<sup>nd</sup> petal)
4. dc into each stitch all the way round 1<sup>st</sup> petal, except 2 dc into middle stitch of ddtr marked \*, ss into , and 2 dc into both ddtr marked \*\*, ss between 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> petals and at end.

Sew in ends, possible leaving the black ends to tie onto display, depending on what it is for.



### Leaf Pattern

Make a ss and 8ch

1. Start in 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from hook as follows:
  - Dc, htr, tr, 2tr, tr, htr, dc
2. 2ch, ss into second ch from hook – this forms the point of the leaf
3. Work back up the other side of the leaf, mirroring the first side
  - Dc, htr, tr, 2tr, tr, htr, dc
4. Ss into end of leaf and fasten off, leaving a tail to attach leaf to poppy.  
Sew in the tail at the other end.
